


By partnering with iDiC, our clients are able to access the network of 100+ Indigenous businesses in the iDiC consortium. As a single point deployment model, iDiC partners with clients under a Master Services Agreement as a pre-qualified Indigenous supplier. Opportunities are subcontracted by iDiC, to one or more partners in iDiC's consortium, to deliver the service.

Our Strategic Partnership approach allows our clients to bring about greater opportunity for Indigenous businesses to engage with the organisation and addresses the challenges faced by many Indigenous suppliers when they seek to go through challenging and often lengthy accreditation and onboarding processes.


